The Base NZ Park Attack is back! We will be in the new McPark & the Antler Alley jumps. Divisions are U14 (born in 2006 or later) & Open. Freestyle tricks over jumps, boxes & rails are judged by a panel of 3 judges with scores based on variety, difficulty & execution. Medals & prizes are presented for 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> in each age division for ski & snowboard. Helmets must be worn by all competitors.

### SSNZ SLOPESTYLE SERIES

### AGE DIVISIONS

The Base NZ Park Attack Slopestyle is a Ski & Snowboard competition. There are 2 age divisions:

- U14 (born in 2006 or after)
- Open (all ages)

Age refers to age on January 1, 2019

### HOW TO ENTER

Entry is \$35, child's lift pass \$45, students lift pass (18+) \$65, & adult lift pass \$90. Parent passes are available at \$90. Competitors can preregister online at [cardrona.com/events](http://cardrona.com/events) or on the day in the ticket office. To receive SSNZ points for the slopestyle series competitors must be a member of Snow Sports NZ.
