

SOUTH ISLAND SECONDARY SCHOOLS CHAMPIONSHIPS

The South Island Secondary Schools Champs is an interschool competition for secondary schools located in the South Island regions. Competitors can compete in Giant Slalom & Slopestyle competitions. Each school can enter boys, girls, & mixed gender teams or individuals of snowboarders & skiers.

Entries & Eligibility

Students must be under the age of 19yrs as at 1 January 2019 & fulfil the eligibility criteria for competition in secondary school sport as defined by the School Sports NZ. Students in years 7 & 8 are **not** eligible to participate. This event is open to individuals however competitors **must** have competed in their own (Otago/Southland, Canterbury, Tasman or Aoraki) event to be eligible. A team must consist of 3 or 4 competitors who enter ski or snowboard disciplines. A mixed team should include 1-2 boys & 1-2 girls. Every team member is also entered in as an individual for overall individual results in GS & Slopestyle. The overall team results will be determined from the top 3 team members individual results from GS & Slopestyle (in each discipline & category).

Competitors must enter one of the following divisions for teams:

Boys Ski team	Girls Ski team	Mixed Ski team
Boys Snowboard team	Girls Snowboard team	Mixed Snowboard team

Event Format

Giant Slalom (GS): Ski & snowboard competitors must inspect the course before completing 2 timed runs. The 2 times are combined to determine the result. The Giant Slalom will be held on the upper Goldrush trail.

Slopestyle (SS): Slopestyle is a judged competition available for both skiers & snowboarders. Competitors will complete 2 judged runs with the best single score determining the result. The Slopestyle course will be held in the Antlers Alley terrain park & will include the top 3 jumps only.

How to Enter

Entries are to be completed through each school's sports department. The entry fee is \$35 per competitor. Lift tickets are available at an event rate of \$45 per day for competitors. The total team entry fee & lift passes must be paid by credit card along with the entry form. Parent passes are available on the day only in the Slopeside Ticket Office for \$90.

Please email Amy for any questions events.admin@cardrona.com. Entries close 5 days prior to the event. If a school should provide a volunteer to help as a course marshal, they will receive a complimentary day pass, this also includes the optional Sunday September 15th day. All teams are welcome to ski & snowboard for the same discounted price on Sunday, September 15th.
