EVENT DESCRIPTION

Cardrona Alpine Resort in collaboration with Snow Sports New Zealand are hosting a Freestyle Australia New Zealand Cup (ANC) event consisting of a Big Air, Halfpipe then Slopestyle competition. The event is scheduled during the annual New Zealand Freestyle National Champs which has multiple disciplines scheduled for various age divisions however only FIS registered athletes will contest the ANC events listed below.

ENTRIES & REGISTRATION

All athletes participating in the FIS ANC must have a valid FIS license issued under the authority of their national ski association and be current members of Snow Sports NZ.

Australia and New Zealand may enter up to 40 men and 20 women in each discipline.

For competitors from other nations the maximum is 10 (8 max per gender). The organiser has discretion to accept additional athletes above the quota if there is space in the start list. The ANC rules are available on the [FIS website](#).

How to enter:

All FIS entries are completed by each National Association on the official FIS entry form. Entry forms must be sent to Snow sports NZ via e-mail to: sami@snowsports.co.nz by 5pm on 15th September (NZST). Athletes included on their NSA's FIS entry form must then pay their event entry fees on the Snow Sports NZ website [here](#) by 5pm on 22nd September (NZST). The entry fee per discipline is \$60.

Late entries may not be accepted. 50% discounted competitor passes are available for training and competition days (2 days prior).

COMPETITOR BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs appropriately during all scheduled trainings and competition. Bibs will be available to collect at the Team Captains meeting or from 7.45am at Slopeside Guest services on competition days. We kindly ask for these bibs to be returned to Slopeside ticket office.



TEAM CAPTAIN'S MEETINGS

Team Captains meetings will be hosted at 6pm the day prior to each competition day. The TCM will be hosted at Apres which is the Cardrona/Treble Cone Wanaka office located at 50 Cardrona Valley Road, Wanaka. Bibs and lift tickets will be issued at the TCM along with event updates and information.

LIFT PASSES & RESORT COMMUNICATION

Competitor lift passes will be available at 50% off the normal day pass rate. Registered competitors can purchase a discounted pass for any days between 28th September and the last day of competition. Coaches can receive a complimentary coaches pass if they have 6 or more athletes. For teams with less than 6 coaches passes will be available at (50% discount).

AWARDS

There will be an awards presentation held in Cardrona's courtyard at the conclusion of each discipline. Medals will be awarded for 1st - 3rd podium places. FIS points and rankings will be calculated from competitors placing, ranking and points.

WEATHER POSTPONEMENTS

The weather day is scheduled for the 4th of October. There is one weather day scheduled for the FIS ANC. If an event is postponed, it will move to the postponement day. Postponement details will be discussed at the 1st TCM and updates will be forwarded via the WhatsApp group communication.
