

# DAKINE SUPER-D

Sunday February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020

Cardrona Alpine Resort, NZ



The Dakine Super-D is a 4-hour endurance downhill race - with chairlift uploads! The course follows Ridge-Rider from the top to bottom of Whitestar. Totalling approximately 2km long and 350m descent, with only 15m of climbing! Ridge-rider is a blue technical flow trail. Competitors can enter as a team (maximum of 3 per team) or an individual.

## RACE FORMAT

The race kicks off under the Cardrona archway with a mass start & sprint down to Whitestar Express. Racers get lift priority however, there is a maximum of only 2 riders per chair. A race pit area for transitions, maintenance, ride breaks & refreshments will be set up at the bottom of Whitestar Express. Competitor vehicles can be parked in the pit area & competitors will be directed down to Whitestar after they have registered.

Riders must follow the marked trail down Ridge-Rider which will have designated overtaking areas & alternative routes for slower riders. Racers will be permitted to upload the chairlift for 4 hours after the race start. All competitors must start each lap from the bottom of Whitestar after they exit the pits. The team or individuals completing the most laps in the fastest time will step onto the podium.

## HOW TO ENTER

Entry fee is \$30 for an individual or \$60 for a team of 2 - 3 racers. Discounted full day lift passes are available at \$50 for adults & \$30 for racers 17yrs & under.

## ENTRY DIVISIONS

Individual: Open Men, Open Ladies, Jr. Boys

Teams: Jr. Boys & Jr. Girls & Jr. Mixed (U17), Open Men & Open Ladies and Mixed Team

*Note: The mixed (Gender) teams must include a female & male result. Jr. Girls Individual division based on demand*

## SCHEDULE

9am - 10.30am	Race registration - Cardrona ticket office
10am - 10.45am	Pits set up & vehicle parking (Bottom of Whitestar)
11am	Rider's briefing in the Cardrona Courtyard
11.30am	Race start from archway
3.30pm	Teams & individual race finishes
4pm	Results & awards presentation at the pit area (bottom of Whitestar)

## RESULTS & AWARDS

Results are calculated on the number of laps completed within the 4-hour period & the time difference between riders as they cross the finish line. Awards will be presented for podium results for all divisions. Individual results will be presented for 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup>. Teams awards are presented for 1<sup>st</sup> place only (Each team member receives a prize). Complimentary beverages are available at the awards for all competitors.
