The Mount Aspiring College Champs is the first of three secondary school events in the region. The MAC Champs competition is for MAC students only. Disciplines include an off-piste Banked Slalom and a Park Slopestyle in Antlers Alley terrain park. Results from the MAC Champs will enable students to assemble their teams for the Otago Southland and South-Island inter-secondary school champs scheduled later in the season. Results are announced on the day and awards are presented at the school assembly.

BANKED SLALOM: Ski | Snowboard | Male | Female
PARK SLOPESTYLE: Ski | Snowboard | Male | Female

ENTRY

The entry fee is \$30 and must be paid to Mount Aspiring College with a completed entry form. A waiver form must also be signed prior to collecting competitor bibs. Cardrona will NOT charge a bib deposit however bibs that are not returned will be invoiced to Mount Aspiring College. Competitors can collect a discounted lift pass for \$55. There will be a discounted Event Parent Pass available to purchase on the day.

EVENT REGISTRATION & BIB ALLOCATION

Competitor bibs will be collected from 7am - 8.30am on the competition day at the event registration desk in the Slopeside ticket office. Please ensure all team managers collect all bibs and lift passes between these times.

EVENT SCHEDULE

12:30pm	Snowboard Slopestyle Practice (40 minutes)
1:15pm	Snowboard Slopestyle Judged Runs
3:30pm	Results posted online

EVENT FORMAT:

The Banked Slalom (BSL) results are determined by the single fastest of 2 timed runs through the course. Competitors who miss a gate or go around the wrong side of the flag will be disqualified and will not receive a time for that run although they will get a 2nd chance as all competitors complete 2 timed runs

The Slopestyle event is freestyle competition judged by a panel of 3 judges who assign scores based on Variety, Difficulty and Execution. Deductions are made for falls & faults. The single best score from the 2 runs will determine the slopestyle results.

AWARDS

Individual results will be provided to MAC & awards will be presented at the school assembly.
