EVENT DESCRIPTION

This event is open to all intermediate & primary school pupils from the Upper Clutha Region. The Upper Clutha Primary Schools race is a team event. Teams must consist of 3-4 children & may be all boys, all girls, or mixed. Each team is encouraged to register with a unique team name. All teams must have a team co-ordinator (adult) for contact purposes. A school may enter more than one team.

This race will consist of a single timed run on the Gravity-cross course and a single timed run in the GS course. Competitors will be permitted to inspect the course prior. Team results are determined by the fastest 3 times combined from each team. Individual podiums are also awarded for the single fastest combined times for ski, snowboard, boys and girls. Helmets are compulsory & no race suits are to be worn.

DISCIPLINES

Ski & Snowboard Giant Slalom & Gravity X (single timed run each, combined time).
Due to COVID group restrictions, teams will be divided into 2 groups (A & B)

ENTRIES

Registration closes on Friday 17th September 2021 at 4pm. Entries will not be accepted on the day. The event is open to all schools in the Upper Clutha Central Otago area as well as Twizel. Entry is to be completed through the Snow Sports NZ website www.snowsports.co.nz

Your name must be on the list to collect a pass, so pre-arrangement is essential

Please be prepared to use your vehicle as your day lodge, due to COVID restrictions and limits on numbers allowed in cafes. The cafes are for seated dining only. In bad weather sitting outside may not be an option.

Face coverings must be worn in the cafes, on lifts, lift queues and Race start Arena.
