## EVENT DESCRIPTION

The Treble Cone Banked Slalom is New Zealand's longest-running snowboard event and a great social catch up for all ages. For 2024 the race has a new format with qualifications scheduled on the Saturday and finals on Sunday. There is also a scheduled training day with Camp3 on the Friday. Both competition days will have the same format whereby competitors get 2 timed runs with the single fastest time determining who moves from qualifications to finals and then onto the podium. Previous Podium places can advance straight to the final day OR risk getting knocked off during the qualifiers.

## HOW TO ENTER

Pre-registration is available online or at any of Cardrona/TC ticket offices before midnight on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> August.
